- Visit Cape Tribulation Beach, where the rainforest meets the reef



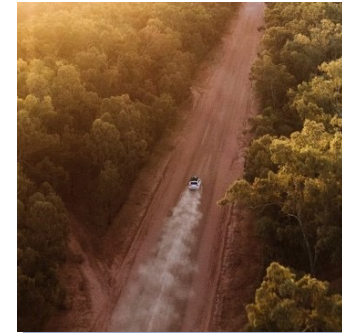


MISSION BEACH
